Transit Map for the Joseon Royal Tombs Route

The Royal Tombs of the Joseon Dynasty is a collection of burial places of kings and queen consorts of the Joseon Dynasty along with the burial places of the emperors and empress consorts of the Korean Empire. Most of the royal tombs – from that of the first ruler of the Joseon Dynasty (King Taejo) through that of the second and final ruler of the Korean Empire (Emperor Sunjong) – are found in and around the capital area (including the part now in North Korea). The forty royal tombs located in the Republic of Korea have been inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List.

The Transit Map for the Joseon Royal Tombs Route provides a suggested route for visiting royal tombs. The QR codes next to the name of each royal tomb will link you to Google Maps. Designate that location as your destination and click on "Directions" to plan your visit.

① This map contains public transit information on the Joseon Royal Tombs that are currently open to the public (as of May 2024).

② The transit information features only the shortest routes, and only the subway stations that are directly involved in the route to the tombs are indicated on the map.
